| 2. tion as in action | 9. cian as in magician |
| 3. tian as in Egyptian | 10. cion as in suspicion |
| 4. tien as in patient | 11. cien as in ancient |
| 5. sion as in mansion | 12. shion as in fashion |
| 6. sian as in Russian | 13. chion as in stanchion |
| 7. sien as in transient | 14. xion as in complexion |

T-i, s-i, c-i and c-e usually copy s-h before a vowel.

SECRET VOWEL: A, E, O & U are long before t-i, s-i, c-i & c-e. I is short.
